- Area 93 consists of 41 Districts, 1003 groups registered, 10 virtual groups and 244 unknown groups (active but have no GSR rep)
- District 22 consists of 93 active groups (with GSR’s) and 18 unknown groups
- General Service changed databases and when they did that all the group numbers were reassigned. Groups can still use their old numbers while the transitioning is in effect
- Groups can now register online, as well as, submitting paper form
- When registering a new GSR they can have an electronic version, a paper version or opt out. GSR packets are now being tracked
