

ALTERNATE DISTRICT COMMITTEE MEMBER (ADCM)

Description

- Same as that of the DCM

Responsibilities

- In conjunction with the DCM, performs the same duties as the DCM and be fully capable of assuming the position of DCM if the DCM is unable to serve.
If the DCM cannot attend an Area Assembly or Area Committee Meeting, the ADCM will go in their place and can vote if necessary.

- In addition, hosts two District events a year. Typically they are:
Service Workshop – Co-hosts with the Vice-Chair of the Central Office Intergroup. If possible, this is when the Area Delegate will be invited to give their report of the General Service Conference.

Traditions Luncheon – A celebration of the Traditions

Other workshops – If there is a need

Note: The ADCM can and is encouraged to form a subcommittee to help with the workshops.

Also note: Some years we were only able to put on one workshop or luncheon, where the Delegate gave her report. We do what we can.

- Attend the monthly District meeting (in person or by Zoom)

Elections

- The same procedure as used for the DCM.
- If the DCM is unable to serve the ADCM will assume the position of DCM, and the District Committee will elect a new ADCM.
- An ADCM who completes the term of the DCM shall be eligible to run for election as DCM for their own term.
