Liaisons

District 22 has several liaison positions available. Currently they are:

- Convention
- H and I
- Intergroup
- SLOPYPAA
- Spanish District 6

The Descriptions and Appointment/Election is the same for all the liaison positions. The Responsibilities may vary.

Description

- The term of office is for two (2) years to run concurrent with that of the DCM.
- It is strongly suggested the liaison resign as GSR, as it is not practical for one to be of service in both positions, in addition they probably have a service commitment with the committee they are representing.

Appointment/Election

- The liaison positions are appointed by the committee they represent. (i.e.: H & I would appoint someone from their committee.)
- On their first visit to the District meeting, they are approved by the District by a yea/nay majority vote.

Responsibilities

- Attend meetings of the committee they are representing
- Attend the monthly District meeting (in person or by Zoom)
- Give a brief (3 5 minutes) report of news from the committee they are representing
- Share flyers of events from their committee.
 - Email or give a copy of the flyers to our webmaster to put on our website d22aa.org.
- Share with their committee current District events (i.e.: share if we are putting on a Service Workshop, share flyers) if the committee they represent allows.
- Assist the DCM and ADCM in whatever areas they request help.

Additional Responsibilities of the Liaisons

• **Convention** – The liaison will furnish the District with the Convention website and how to register. They will invite volunteers to be on the Convention Committee, which meets most months at noon, after our District meeting. The convention is usually held at the Vet's Hall in San Luis Obispo in August on a Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

- Hospitals and Institutions (H & I) The liaison will announce if any of the facilities they take meetings into has a need for volunteers. Tell us what the clearance process is, sobriety requirements, and how one can apply to do this service. They will also periodically announce if any Bridging the Gap volunteers are needed. The H & I Committee meets on the 3rd Tuesday on Zoom at 6:30 p.m.
- **Intergroup** The liaison is usually the Vice Chair of the Central Office Intergroup. It has been the custom of the Vice Chair to co-host with the District's ADCM, a Service Workshop, where the Area Delegate will give her report on the General Service Conference. They are also invited to participate in our other workshops or luncheons.

The District will sometimes ask the SLOPYAA members to participate in our events (i.e.: Traditions Play at the Traditions Luncheon.) *Young people = young in age, young at heart, and those with room to grow.

• **Spanish District 6** – Share with us how the Spanish Groups are doing in District 6. We have it in our budget to fund the District 6 Liaison to attend El Foro (a conference for the Spanish groups in Area 06, usually held in October). If they attend, they will present a written and verbal report to our District.
